DIVIDE FOR FRONTS AND BACK		
The actual pattern is written in a way that requires the knitter to understand how to change the stitch pattern when a full stitch repeat cannot be completed due to bind offs or shaping. Many patterns are written this way and it is important to understand how you can do this.		
Nxt Row: this is a	However, to make the pattern easier for you, I've written the instructions specifically for each size.	
Row 9 (RS)	Follow the instructions below for the size you are making.	
X-Small	(K2, P2) 5 times, slip marker, K1, (K3, 5-wrap, K4) 2 times, k7, place the last 52 stitches just worked on scrap yarn, bind off 6, k2, 5-wrap, k4, (k3, 5-wrap, k4) 4 times, k3, 5-wrap, k2, bind off 6, k8, (k3, 5-wrap, k4) 2 times, slip marker, (P2, K2) 5 times, place the last 52 stitches just worked on scrap yarn. This means you now have the fronts on scrap yarn and only the stitches for the back are on the needle.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Small	(K2, P2) 5 times, slip marker, K1, (K3, 5-wrap, K4) 3 times, k2, place the last 59 stitches just worked on scrap yarn, bind off 6, k4, (K3, 5-wrap, k4) 6 times, k3, bind off 6, k3, (k3, 5-wrap, k4) 3 times, slip marker, (P2, K2) 5 times, place the last 59 stitches just worked on scrap yarn. This means you now have the fronts on scrap yarn and only the stitches for the back are on the needle.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Medium	(K2, P2) 5 times, slip marker, K1, (K3, 5-wrap, K4) 3 times, k2, place the last 59 stitches just worked on scrap yarn, bind off 8, k2, (k3, 5-wrap, k4) 7 times, k1, bind off 8, k3, (k3, 5-wrap, k4) 3 times, slip marker, (P2, K2) 5 times, place the last 59 stitches just worked on scrap yarn. This means you now have the fronts on scrap yarn and only the stitches for the back are on the needle.	<input type="checkbox"/>
Large	(K2, P2) 5 times, slip marker, K1, (K3, 5-wrap, K4) 3 times, k8, place the last 65 stitches just worked on scrap yarn, bind off 10, k6, (K3, 5-wrap, k4) 7 times, k5, bind off 10, k9, (k3, 5-wrap, k4) 3 times, slip marker, (P2, K2) 5 times, place the last 65 stitches just worked on scrap yarn. This means you now have the fronts on scrap yarn and only the stitches for the back are on the needle.	<input type="checkbox"/>
X-Large	(K2, P2) 5 times, slip marker, K1, (K3, 5-wrap, K4) 4 times, k2, place the last 71 stitches just worked on scrap yarn, bind off 12, [1 stitch on needle] 5-Wrap, K4, (k3, 5-wrap, k4) 7 times, K3, 5-wrap, K1, bind off 12, [1 stitch on needle] k2, (k3, 5-wrap, k4) 4 times, slip marker, (P2, K2) 5 times, place the last 71 stitches just worked on scrap yarn. This means you now have the fronts on scrap yarn and only the stitches for the back are on the needle.	<input type="checkbox"/>
2 X-Large	(K2, P2) 5 times, slip marker, K1, (K3, 5-wrap, K4) 4 times, k2, place the last 76 stitches just worked on scrap yarn, bind off 16, k1, 5-wrap, k4, (K3, 5-wrap, k4) 7 times, k3, 5-wrap, k1, bind off 16, k3, (K3, 5-wrap, k4) 4 times, slip marker, (P2, K2) 5 times, place the last 76 stitches just worked on scrap yarn. This means you now have the fronts on scrap yarn and only the stitches for the back are on the needle.	<input type="checkbox"/>
3 X-Large	(K2, P2) 5 times, slip marker, K1, (K3, 5-wrap, K4) 4 times, k8, place the last 77 stitches just worked on scrap yarn, bind off 16, (k3, 5-wrap, k4) 9 times, k3, 5-wrap, k3, bind off 16, k9, (k3, 5-wrap, k4) 4 times, slip marker, (P2, K2) 5 times, place the last 77 stitches just worked on scrap yarn. This means you now have the fronts on scrap yarn and only the stitches for the back are on the needle.	<input type="checkbox"/>
