SKILL LEVEL

Easy

MEASUREMENTS

Finished Measurements (before blocking)

Scarf: 9" x 62" [23 x 157.5 cm], or desired length

Cowl: 9" x 30" [23 x 76 cm], or desired length

Gauge

31 dc = 9" [23 cm]; use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

MATERIALS

Yarn

Yarnspirations, *Caron Cakes* (80% acrylic, 20% wool, 445 yds / 407 m, 8.5 oz / 240 g, CYCA 4 worsted), Color Me Bold Collection #caroncakes

Blackberry Jelly 1 ball

Hook

Size H/8 [5.0 mm]

Notions

Tapestry needle

ABBREVIATIONS

Ch - Chain(s)

Cont - Continue

Dc - Double Crochet

RS - Right Side

Sp(s) - Space(s)

St(s) - Stitch(es)

Stacked Dc - Stacked Double Crochet

Tch - Turning Chain

WS - Wrong Side

SPECIAL STITCHES

★ **Stacked Double Crochet (Stacked Dc):** (Do not ch 1 prior to making the first sc) Sc in first stitch, insert hook in between two legs of the base, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook.

DIAGRAM

NOTES

- Crocheted flat in turned rows throughout.
- Work the Stacked Double Crochet in place of a chain 3 turning chain at start of the row for a better finish
- Let the color change as it may
- Make the piece as long as desired. For cowl, stop between 30-45" in length then seam ends together.

RIVERSIDE CROCHET SCARF / COWL

BODY

Chain 33.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (skipped 3 chains count as dc) and in each ch across, turn -- 31 dc.

Row 2: Stacked Dc in first st, dc in each st to end, turn.

Row 3: Stacked Dc in first st, dc in each st to end, turn.

Row 4: Stacked Dc in first st, dc in next st, skip 1 st, *(dc, ch 1, dc) in next st, skip 2 sts; repeat from * to last 4 sts, (dc, ch 1, dc) in next st, skip 1 st, dc in last 2 sts, turn — 22 dc, 9 ch-1 spaces.

Row 5: Stacked Dc in first st, dc in next st, skip 1 dc, *(dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-1 sp, skip 2 dc; repeat from * to last ch-1 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in last ch-1 sp, skip 1 dc, dc in last 2 sts, turn.

Row 6: Stacked Dc in first st, dc in next st, skip 1 dc, *(dc, ch 1, dc) in next ch-1 sp, skip 2 dc; repeat from * to last ch-1 sp, (dc, ch 1, dc) in last ch-1 sp, skip 1 dc, dc in last 2 sts, turn.

Row 7: Stacked Dc in first st, dc in each st to end, turn — 31 dc.

Repeat row 2-7 until piece measures desired amount, ending on a row 6 for the cowl, or a row 3 for the scarf.

FINISHING

Scarf: Fasten off, weave in ends.

Cowl: Fasten off leaving a long tail for seaming. Fold the cowl together and with RS facing each other, whip stitch the two short ends together. Weave in ends.
