This knit-lookalike hat pattern is made with a split single crochet ribbing pattern in the round. Super simple and stunning way to show off your crochet skills in the minimalist of ways!

Want even more pizzazz? Why not zhuzh it up with a faux fur pom for extra style and flair? We know you'll love the way it looks in a beautiful speckled hand-dyed yarn – the multicolor is so dreamy!

Go ahead and show off your fashionable sense of style with our **Celebration Crochet Hat Pattern** – you won't regret it!

## GENERAL INFO

### Yarn

**Sock Obsession Yarns, Aran**

Weight (100% superwash merino,

181 yds / 166 m, 3.53 oz / 100 g,

CYCA #4 worsted) - 1 (1,1,1,2)

hanks. Sample color - Tiny River



### **Hook**

Size H/8 (5.0 mm), or any size to achieve gauge.

### **Notions**

- Stitch Markers
- Tapestry needle to bury the ends
- (optional) Pom Pom

### **Gauge**

16 sts by 17 rounds in stitch pattern = 4" [10 cm] by 4" [10 cm]; use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**CH** - CHAIN (S)  
**PM** - PLACE MARKER  
**RS** - RIGHT SIDE  
**SC** - SINGLE CROCHET

**SL ST** - SLIP STITCH  
**ST(S)** - STITCH(ES)  
**WS** - WRONG SIDE

## SPECIAL STITCHES

- ★**Back Loop Only:** This is the furthest loop to you of the top 2 loops of the stitch indicated, regardless if you are on the RS or WS.
- ★**Chain (ch):** With slip knot or free loop on hook, yarn over hook and pull through loop on hook.
- ★**Single Crochet (sc):** Insert hook into indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook.
- ★**Slip Stitch (sl st):** Insert hook into indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop and draw through loop on hook.
- ★**Single Crochet 2 Together (sc2tog):** \*Insert hook into indicated stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop; repeat from \* in next stitch indicated, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.
- ★**Split Single Crochet (split sc):** Insert hook into indicated titch between the two legs of the stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through both loops on hook.
- ★**Split Single Crochet/Single Crochet Decrease (split sc/sc dec):** Insert hook into indicated stitch between the two legs of the stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, insert hook into the back loop of the next indicated st, yarn over and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook - *1 stitch decreased.*
- ★**Split Single Crochet Two Together (split sc2tog):** Insert hook into indicated stitch between the two legs of the stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop, insert hook into next stitch indicated between the two legs of the stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop yarn over and draw through all loops on hook - *1 stitch decreased.*

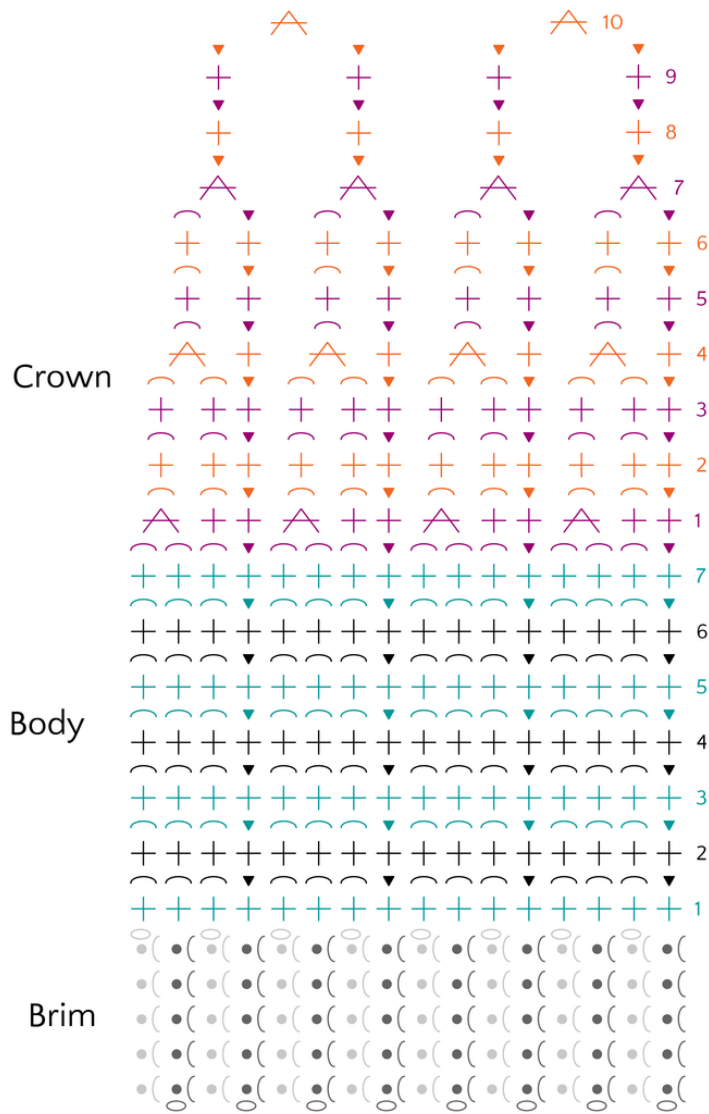

## NOTES

- Use markers in the first slip stitch of the brim on each row to help keep count.
- Be cautious when working the slip stitches on the brim, maintain consistent tension or the stitches will begin to get too tight as the brim gets longer.
- The slip stitches should NOT be any more snug than the size of the hook.
- Brim of hat is worked flat then seamed together.
- Body of hat is worked into the long side edge of the brim as instructed.
- Body of hat is worked in continuous rounds. Use a marker to identify the first stitch of each round.
- Body st gauge near the brim will be a little more snug than it is in the body of the hat. The gauge given is in the body of hat.
- Directions are for size Toddler; changes for sizes Kid, S, M, L are in parentheses. When only one number is given then that number applies to all sizes.
- Stitches are worked in back loop only unless otherwise stated in the body of the hat.

## PATTERN

### BRIM

Chain 6.

**Row 1:** Sl st in back loop of 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, ch 1, turn – 5 sts.

**Row 2:** Sl st in the back loop only of each slip stitch across, ch 1, turn – 5 sts.

Repeat Row 2, 70 (74, 82, 90, 98) more times.-- 36 (38, 42, 46, 50) raised ridges.

Join the foundation row (*chain edge*) to the last row (*working edge*) with a slip stitch into the back loop only of the working edge and the front loop of the chain edge, repeat across row. See video tutorial for help, DO NOT FASTEN OFF.

### BODY

Turn to begin working on long edge of brim (*in the row ends*), ch 1.

**Set-up round 1:** Working into the slip stitch edge, sc into the “V” of the slip stitch ridge, and sc into the gully between the ridges, do not turn – 72 (76, 84, 92, 100) sts.

**Round 1:** Split sc in the first st of the round, \*sc in the back loop of next 3 sts, split sc in next sc; repeat from \* around to last 3 sts, sc in the back loop of last 3 sts.

Repeat Round 1 until hat measures 5.5 (5.5, 6, 6, 6.5) “ [14 (14, 15, 15, 16.5) cm] from brim edge.



## CROWN

**Round 1 (decrease round):** \*Split sc in next sc, sc in the back loop of next st, sc2tog in back loop of next 2 sts; repeat from \* around – 54 (57, 63, 69, 75) sts.

**Round 2 and 3:** \*Split sc in next sc, sc in the back loop of next 2 sts; repeat from \* around.

**Round 4 (decrease round):** \*Split sc in next sc, sc2tog in back loop of next 2 sts; repeat from \* around – 36 (38, 42, 46, 50) sts.

**Round 5 and 6:** \*Split sc in next sc, sc in back loop of next st; repeat from \* around.

**Round 7 (decrease):** \*Split sc/sc dec (*see special stitches*) in next 2 sts; repeat from \* around – 18 (19, 21, 23, 25) sts.

**Round 8 and 9:** Split sc in each st around.

**Round 10 (decrease):** \*Split sc2tog (*see special stitches*) in next 2 sts; repeat from \* around to last stitch, split sc in last st, sl st to first st – 9 (10, 11, 12, 13) sc. Fasten off leaving a long tail.

## FINISHING

With the tail thread through a tapestry needle, weave the top closed.

Weave in all ends

Optional: add a pom pom.

## GENERAL INFO

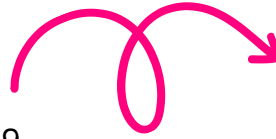
### Yarn

#### Brediculous, AUBS Worsted

(100% Superwash Merino, 218 yds / 199

m, 3½ oz / 100 g CYCA #4 worsted)

*Hello Gorgeous* - 1 (1, 1, 1, 2) hanks of yarn



### Needles

US 7 (4.5mm) 16" circulars; set of five size 7 double pointed needles.

Adjust size to obtain correct gauge.

### Notions

- Stitch markers
- Tapestry needle
- Removable pom pom button (optional)
- Faux Fur pom pom (optional)

### Gauge

20 sts = 4" [10 cm] in Lifted Knit Ribbing.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**K** – KNIT

**K2TOG** – KNIT 2 TOGETHER

**P** – PURL

**PM** – PLACE MARKER

**RS** – RIGHT SIDE

**SL** – SLIP STITCH

**ST(S)** – STITCH(ES)

## SPECIAL STITCHES

★ **1x1 Ribbing:** Knit one, purl one; repeat from \*

★ **Knit Two Together (k2tog):** Knit 2 stitches together – 1 stitch decreased.

★ **Lifted Knit:** With yarn in back, insert right needle upwards through the purl bar 2 rows below, knit next stitch on left needle, pass the lifted bar over the knit stitch.

## PATTERN STITCH

### Lifted Knit Ribbing

Worked in the round over a multiple of 4 sts.

**Round 1:** Purl.

**Round 2:** Knit.

**Round 3:** P3, **Lifted Knit** (*see Video Tutorials*); repeat from \* around.

**Round 4:** Knit.

Repeat rounds 1-4 for **Lifted Knit Ribbing**.

### Flat Lifted Knit Ribbing

Worked flat over a multiple of 4 sts.

**Note:** Flat version of Lifted Knit Ribbing is given for the purpose of measuring gauge. The actual hat is worked entirely in the round.

**Row 1 (RS):** Purl.

**Row 2:** Purl.

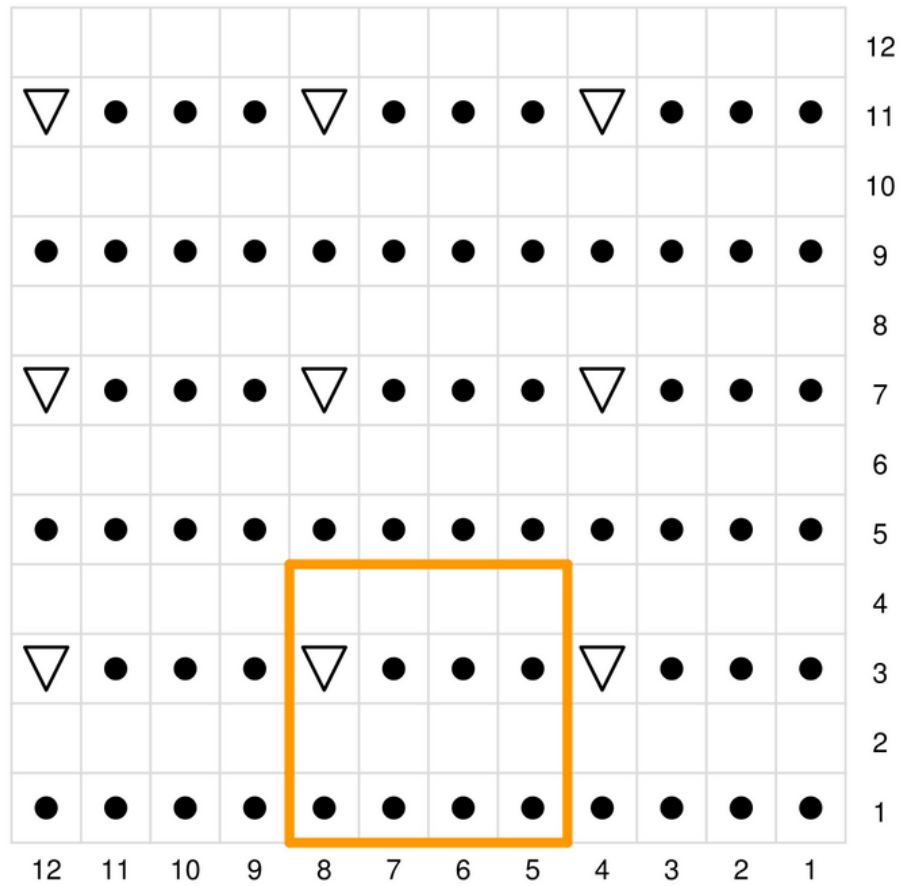
**Row 3:** P3, **Lifted Knit** (*see Video Tutorials*); repeat from \* around.






**Row 4:** Purl.

Repeat rows 1-4 Flat Lifted Knit Ribbing.

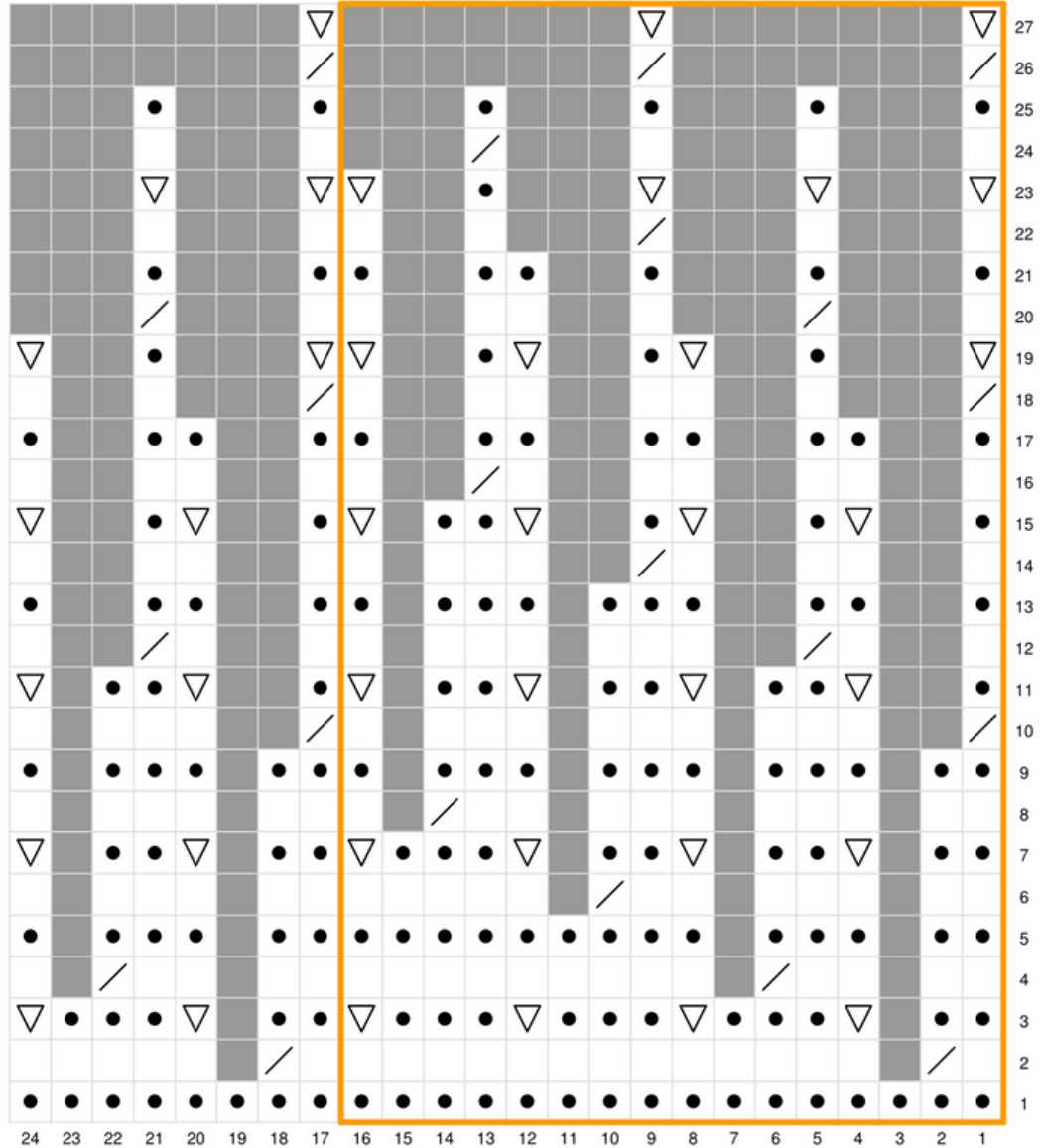
## Body of the hat

## PATTERN

### BRIM

With circular needles, cast on 80 (92, 100, 108, 112) sts.  
Join round and mark first st.

**Round 1:** Knit.

**Round 2:** \* K1, p1; repeat from \* to end of round.

Repeat Round 2 only for 1" [2.5 cm].

### BODY

Work in **Lifted Knit Ribbing** until hat measures 3½ (4½, 5, 5½, 6)" [9 (11.5, 12.5, 14, 15) cm] from cast-on edge.

### CROWN

*For Sizes Toddler, Adult Small, and Adult Large (first, third, and fifth sizes) only:*

**Round 1:** Purl.

**Round 2 (decrease round):** \* K1, k2tog, k13; repeat from \* around — 75 (x, 90, x, 105) sts; 15 sts in each section.

**Round 3:** \* P2, Lifted Knit, [p3, Lifted Knit] 3 times; repeat from \* around.

**Round 4 (decrease round):** \* K4, k2tog, k9; repeat from \* around — 70 (x, 84, x, 98) sts; 14 sts in each section.

**Round 5:** Purl.

**Round 6 (decrease round):** \* K7, k2tog, k5; repeat from \* around — 65 (x, 78, x, 91) sts; 13 sts in each section.

**Round 7:** \* [P2, Lifted Knit] 3 times, p3, Lifted Knit; repeat from \* around.

**Round 8 (decrease round):** \* K10, k2tog, k1; repeat from \* around — 60 (x, 72, x, 84) sts; 12 sts in each section.

**Round 9:** Purl.

**Round 10 (decrease round):** \* K2tog, k10; repeat from \* around — 55 (x, 66, x, 77) sts; 11 sts in each section.

## CROWN SHAPING CONT

*For Sizes Toddler, Adult Small, and Adult Large (first, third, and fifth sizes) only:*

**Round 11:** \* P1, Lifted Knit, [p2, Lifted Knit] 3 times; repeat from \* around.

**Round 12 (decrease round):** \* K2, k2tog, k7; repeat from \* around — 50 (x, 60, x, 70) sts; 10 sts in each section.

**Round 13:** Purl.

**Round 14 (decrease round):** \* K4, k2tog, k4; repeat from \* around — 45 (x, 54, x, 63) sts; 9 sts in each section.

**Round 15:** \* [P1, Lifted Knit] 3 times, p2, Lifted Knit; repeat from \* around.

**Round 16 (decrease round):** \* K6, k2tog, k1; repeat from \* around — 40 (x, 48, x, 56) sts; 8 sts in each section.

**Round 17:** Purl.

**Round 18 (decrease round):** \* K2tog, k6; repeat from \* around — 35 (x, 42, x, 49) sts; 7 sts in each section.

**Round 19:** \* Lifted Knit, [p1, Lifted Knit] 3 times; repeat from \* around.

**Round 20 (decrease round):** \* K1, k2tog, k4; repeat from \* around — 30 (x, 36, x, 42) sts; 6 sts in each section.

**Round 21:** Purl.

**Round 22 (decrease round):** \* K2, k2tog, k2; repeat from \* around — 25 (x, 30, x, 35) st; 5 sts in each section.

**Round 23:** Lifted Knit 3 times, p1, Lifted Knit; repeat from \* around.

**Round 24 (decrease round):** \* K3, k2tog; repeat from \* around — 20 (x, 24, x, 28) sts; 4 sts in each section.

**Round 25:** Purl.

**Round 26 (decrease round):** \* K2tog; repeat from \* around — 10 (x, 12, x, 14) sts; 2 sts in each section.

**Round 27:** Lifted Knit around.  
Cut yarn leaving a 10" [25 cm] tail.

## CROWN SHAPING

*For Sizes Kid and Adult Medium (second and fourth sizes) only:*

**Round 1:** Purl.

**Round 2 (decrease round):** \* K1, k2tog, k13; repeat from \* x (4, x, 5, x) more times, k1, k2tog, k5 - x (82, x, 97, x) sts; 15 sts in each section except last, 7 sts in last section.

**Round 3:** \* P2, Lifted Knit, [p3, **Lifted Knit**] 3 times; repeat from \* around x (4, x, 5, x) times, p2, **Lifted Knit**, p3, Lifted Knit.

**Round 4 (decrease round):** \* K4, k2tog, k9; repeat from \* x (4, x, 5, x) more times, k4, k2tog, k1 - x (76, x, 90, x) sts; 14 sts in each section except last, 6 sts in last section.

**Round 5:** Purl.

**Round 6 (decrease round):** \* K7, k2tog, k5; repeat from \* x (4, x, 5, x) more times, k6 - x (71, x, 84, x) sts; 13 sts in each section except last, 6 sts in last section.

**Round 7:** \* [P2, Lifted Knit] 3 times, p3, Lifted Knit; repeat from \* x (4, x, 5, x) more times, [p2, Lifted Knit] twice.

**Round 8 (decrease round):** \* K10, k2tog, k1; repeat from \* x (4, x, 5, x) more times, k6 - x (66, x, 78, x) sts; 12 sts in each section except last, 6 sts in last section.

**Round 9:** Purl.

**Round 10 (decrease round):** \* K2tog, k10; repeat from \* x (4, x, 5, x) more times, k2tog, k4 - x (60, x, 71, x) sts; 11 sts in each section except last, 5 sts in last section.

**Round 11:** \* P1, Lifted Knit, [p2, Lifted Knit] 3 times; repeat from \* x (4, x, 5, x) more times, p1, Lifted Knit, p2, Lifted Knit.

**Round 12 (decrease round):** \* K2, k2tog, k7; repeat from \* x (4, x, 5, x) more times, k2, k2tog, k1 - x (54, x, 64, x) sts, 10 sts in each section except last, 4 sts in last section.



## CROWN SHAPING CONT

*For Sizes Kid and Adult Medium (second and fourth sizes) only:*

**Round 13:** Purl.

**Round 14 (decrease round):** \* K4, k2tog, k4; repeat from \* x (4, x, 5, x) more times, k4 - x (49, x, 58, x) sts, 9 sts in each section except last, 4 sts in last section.

**Round 15:** \* [P1, Lifted Knit] 3 times, p2, Lifted Knit; repeat from \* x (4, x, 5, x) more times, [p1, Lifted Knit] twice.

**Round 16 (decrease round):** \* K6, k2tog, k1; repeat from \* x (4, x, 5, x) more times, k4 - x (44, x, 52, x) sts, 8 sts in each section except last, 4 sts in last section.

**Round 17:** Purl.

**Round 18 (decrease round):** \* K2tog, k6; repeat from \* x (4, x, 5, x) more times, k2tog, k2 - x (38, x, 45, x) sts, 7 sts in each section except last, 3 sts in last section.

**Round 19:** \* Lifted Knit, [p1, Lifted Knit] 3 times; repeat from \* x (4, x, 5, x) more times, Lifted Knit, p1, Lifted Knit.

**Round 20 (decrease round):** \* K1, k2tog, k4; repeat from \* x (4, x, 5, x) more times, k1, k2tog - x (32, x, 38, x) sts - 6 sts in each section except last, 2 sts in last section.

**Round 21:** Purl.

**Round 22 (decrease round):** \* K2, k2tog, k2; repeat from \* x (4, x, 5, x) more times, k2 - x (27, x, 32, x) sts, 5 sts in each section except last, 2 sts in last section.

**Round 23:** Lifted Knit 3 times, p1, Lifted Knit; repeat from \* x (4, x, 5, x) more times, Lifted Knit twice.

**Round 24 (decrease round):** \* K3, k2tog; repeat from \* x (4, x, 5, x) more times, k2 - x (22, x, 26, x) sts, 4 sts in each section except last, 2 sts in last section.

**Round 25:** Purl.

**Round 26 (decrease round):** \* K2tog; repeat from \* x (5, x, 6, x) more times - x (11, x, 13, x) sts.

**Round 27:** Lifted Knit around. Cut yarn leaving a 10" [25 cm] tail.

## FINISHING

Use tapestry needle to thread tail through each remaining st knitwise. Pull tail tight like a drawstring and secure to wrong side of Hat.

Weave in all loose ends.

Add Pom Pom to top of hat (*optional, see Video Tutorials*).
