# Tessellated Triangles Crochet Throw

WEEK 2

Skill Level: Intermediate

Crafting Time: Varies

## SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- **Bernat® Fluffee™**  
(9.8 oz/280 g; 415 yds/380 m)

### Version 1:

- **Main Color (MC)** Cream (11001)  
3 balls or 1231 yds/1125.5 m
- **Contrast A** Sunshine Yellow (11010)  
1 ball or 415 yds/380 m
- **Contrast B** Citronella (11003)  
1 ball or 415 yds/380 m
- **Contrast C** Vivid Pink (11006)  
2 balls or 685 yds/626.5 m

**Note:** This is a 4 week Stitch Along: Week 1 is making Triangle Motifs; Week 2 is joining Triangle Motifs; Week 3 is adding Chevron Edging and Week 4 is adding crochet Twisted Fringe.

### Version 2:

- **Main Color (MC)** Afternoon Blue (11004)  
3 balls or 1231 yds/1125.5 m
- **Contrast A** Quartzite (11005)  
1 ball or 415 yds/380 m
- **Contrast B** Ocean Depths (11008)  
2 balls or 685yds/626.5 m
- **Contrast C** Cream (11001)  
1 ball or 415 yds/380 m
- Size U.S. L/11 (8 mm) Susan Bates®  
Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to  
obtain gauge.**
- Susan Bates® yarn needle.

## GAUGES:

10 dc and 6 rows = 4" [10 cm].  
Triangle Motif = 8" [20.5 cm] tall (from middle  
side edge to tip) (or approx 9¼" [23.5 cm] along  
each side edge).

## WEEK 2 - INSTRUCTIONS:


### ABBREVIATIONS:

Rep = Repeat  
 RS = Right side  
 Sl st = Slip stitch  
 Tog = Together  
 WS = Wrong side

### JOINING TRIANGLE MOTIFS:

**Note:** Triangle Motifs will cup/indent slightly during joining. This is intentional and adds to the 3-D appearance along with the Flat Slip Stitch Joining. You will also note that side edges will scallop out. This is addressed with Finishing Side Seams and Final Edging. Using these techniques to straighten side edges after joining ensures all Triangle Motifs maintain same subtle 3-D effect.

**Seaming with Flat Sl St Join:** (RS). With MC, sl st Triangle Motifs tog as shown in Assembly Diagram, working through back loops only, ensuring RS up on all Motifs, and keeping working yarn to WS to create a flat sl st chain detail on RS of work (see diagram). Join Motifs into 6 vertical Strips, having 9 Triangle Motifs in each Strip. Join 6 Strips tog.




Flat Slip Stitch Join


**Note:** Keep working yarn to WS of work so only flat sl st chain is visible on RS.



**Finishing Side Seams:** (RS). Join MC with sl st in bottom corner of Blanket to work up side edge. Working through back loops only, loosely sl st in each st along side of each of 4 Motifs along right-side edge of Blanket, mimicking look of Flat Slip Stitch Join seam. Rep for left-side edge.
